

## HEBREWS 10:24-25

Paul writes, “And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.”

Paul not only says not to forsake the assembly of the saints, but he gives several reasons why this is important.

1. We are to stir up love. We worship God because we love Him. By being in the assembly we are reminded of the reason for being there, and our love is enhanced toward God and one another.
2. We are to stir up good works. Worshiping God with the saints is a good work. In fact there is nothing greater that we can do with our souls. By our presence we are showing that this is a great thing to do. It encourages others to worship
3. By our being in the assembly we exhort others spiritually and make them stronger. Our very presence tells other Christians that the assembly is important to us.
